An activist and "patron saint of female empowerment" (*People*), Glennon is the founder and president of Together Rising, an all-women-led nonprofit organization that has revolutionized grassroots philanthropy — raising over \$40 million for women, families, and children in crisis.

Glennon lives in California with her wife Abby Wambach and their three children.
